

## Whitecliffe Open Day Academic Scholarship – Terms & Conditions (2026)

### Overview

The Whitecliffe Open Day Academic Scholarship is awarded to celebrate prospective students who attend our Open Days and apply to study in 2026.

- Number available: One scholarship per Open Day event
- Open Day dates and campuses:
  - Wellington Campus – 22 August 2025
  - Manukau Campus – 23 August 2025
  - Auckland City Campus – 30 August 2025
  - Christchurch Campus – 5 September 2025
- Value:
  - Either free tuition for a Certificate programme at Whitecliffe in 2026, OR
  - One year of free tuition in a Whitecliffe Bachelor degree programme in 2026

### How to Apply

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must:

1. Attend a Whitecliffe Open Day in 2025.
2. Submit evidence of their highest academic qualification to the Admissions Team during the event.
3. Complete and submit a 2026 Whitecliffe application form at the Open Day.

No separate scholarship application form is required.

### Eligibility

You are eligible if you are:

- A New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident; and
- Meet the entry criteria of the programme you are applying for; and
- Intending to study full-time at Whitecliffe in 2026.

### Terms & Conditions

1. Scholarship awards: One scholarship will be awarded at each 2025 Open Day event.
  - All eligible attendees who both submit their highest academic qualification and complete a 2026 Whitecliffe application form on the day will be entered into the draw.
  - Where more than one eligible application is received on the day, the scholarship will be awarded by random draw.
  - The decision of Whitecliffe is final.
2. Programmes covered: The scholarship is valid for either:
  - One Certificate programme from the list below (2026 start):

- Certificate in Fine Arts
- Certificate in Digital Media
- Certificate in Fashion
- Certificate in Apparel + Fashion Technology
- Certificate in Jewellery
- Certificate in Information Technology (Level 4 or Level 5) , OR

- One year free tuition in a Bachelor programme from the list below (2026 start):

- Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA)
- Bachelor of Sustainable Fashion Design
- Bachelor of Jewellery Design + Technology
- Bachelor of Design + Digital Media
- Bachelor of Applied Computing Technologies
- Bachelor of Fine Arts (Honours)

3. Costs covered: The scholarship covers tuition fees only. It does not cover student levies, materials, or course-related costs. It cannot be redeemed for cash, transferred to any other student or transferred to another provider.

4. Acceptance: Recipients must accept their place in writing within 14 days of receiving the award notification.

5. Enrolment: Recipients must be enrolled full-time for the programme of study in 2026.

6. Retention:

- Scholarship recipients must maintain satisfactory attendance and academic performance throughout the scholarship period.

- Withdrawal from study or transfer to another institution will result in the scholarship being withdrawn.

7. Participation: Scholarship holders are expected to participate in Whitecliffe community life (such as Student Voice, Open Day support, outreach events, or student leadership activities).

8. Variations: Whitecliffe reserves the right to amend these regulations, provided the main purpose of the scholarship is maintained.

9. Scholarships are applicable to locations and modes where programmes are offered.
